### **CMT/CAPT MAS Assessment**

This presentation on the CMT/ CAPT MAS assessment will review the addition of this new alternate assessment option available to students with disabilities in Connecticut public schools. Discussion will revolve around selecting appropriate students, identifying differences between the CMT/CAPT MAS and the standard assessments and exploring some implications of the CMT/CAPT MAS for districts.

He has also been instrumental in the development of Rater Certification Training, a teacher training method that creates and provides video scenarios of students participating in the Connecticut alternate assessment.

**From I-84 East (Waterbury) Exit 35 (left exit) onto Route 72 East.** Take third exit, marked Main Street. At the end of the exit take a right and travel one block to Chestnut Street. Turn right onto Chestnut Street and travel one block to Main Street. Turn right onto Main Street and ITBD is one block on the right.

**From I-84 West (Hartford) Exit 39A onto Route 9 South.** Take Exit 27 - Chestnut Street (left exit). At the end of the exit take a right onto Chestnut Street and proceed through the second light to Main Street. Turn right onto Main Street and ITBD is one block on the right.

**From South (Route 9, 91, or 15) Travel north on Route 9 to Exit 26 (Downtown New Britain Exit).** Go straight at the end of the exit and left at the second traffic light onto Chestnut Street. Go through one traffic light to Main Street. Turn right onto Main Street and ITBD is one block on the right.
